## How-To Use/Generate Recovery Codes for Two-Step Verification

**Tip:** Treat recovery codes as you would your password, NEVER share or distribute them!  
If you've lost or can't access your phone? You'll need to contact [Kahootz Support](#) for assistance.

You must be able to access/log in to your account profile to generate more recovery codes.

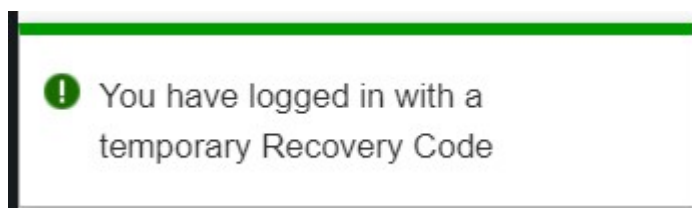
If you cannot gain access to your account profile, you won't be able to follow these steps.

To generate a new set of recovery codes:

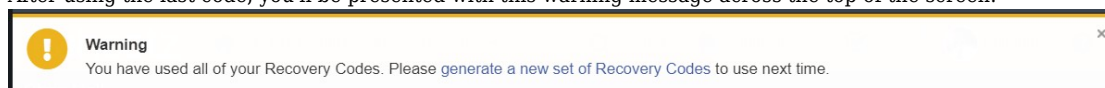
1. Click on your "**Name**" at the top right corner of the page to open your Account menu.
2. Select "**Password & Security**" from the drop-down menu.
3. Click on the "**Recovery Codes**" tab.
4. Enter your "**Current Password**" and click "**Go**".
5. 5 unique single-use-only recovery codes will be displayed, which you can use to log into Kahootz.

**Kahootz Tip:** Recovery codes are single use only, so once used, they cannot be used again.

If you contact support requesting a recovery code, generally, they will provide you with 5 codes.  
When logging into your Kahootz account, enter one of those 5 codes that support provided.



After using the last code, you'll be presented with this warning message across the top of the screen.



Once you've seen this message, we **RECOMMEND** clicking the link above to generate a new set of Recovery Codes.

Recovery codes let you log in when you're unable to access your phone. They are personal, single-use codes that you can use to authenticate your login. We won't show them again once you leave this page so you'll need to store them somewhere safe. Like your password, your recovery codes should not be shared with anyone. If you've lost them, used them all, or they've been compromised, you should generate new recovery codes.
