


## Dashboard Item: Text and Images

Text and images can be used to explain the purpose of your workspace and also instruct users on what they need to do next.

To apply the '**Text and Images**' item to your dashboard:

1. Open the dashboard.
2. Click the '**Configure**' cogwheel icon in the top-right corner.
3. Click '**Add Item**' and select '**Text and Images**' from the drop-down menu.
4. Provide a title if required.
5. Within the '**Content**' section, add your text or images.



6. You can apply various formatting, including (**B**) to **Bold**, (*I*) for *Italic* & (U) for Underline along with inserting images, hyperlinks, and [links to workspace items](#).  
Also, you can align text and images to either the left, centre, or right and add number/bullet points.
