## How-To Use the Comment Form in a Structured Document

The Structured document comment form allows users to provide feedback by capturing comments within the document's text, giving comments their full context.

To view the comment select 'Configure the comment form' from either the Actions menu at the foot of the page or from the ellipsis menus.

### Configure Comment Form

Use drag and drop to change which questions are included and their order

- Use drag & drop to move questions between the 2 lists, the questions shown on the form and the available questions.
- Turn comments on or off for the whole document or save without changing the current selection.
