

## How-To Send & View Private Messages for Users, Workspace Managers & Site Owners)

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You can use "private messages" as Members, Workspace Managers & Site Owners if you have the relevant permissions.

To send or view private messages, please refer to the relevant section below for step-by-step instructions.

### > Users "private messages" are accessed by the following.

Click your "account" icon, which is also your name in the top right corner.

Scroll down and select "Private Messages" from the drop-down menu.


You're now in your private mailbox, displaying all your emails.

\* Press "new private message" to send a new message.

Select "Site Admin" followed by "Private Messages" from the left side menu.

You're now in the Site Owner's mailbox, displaying all the Site Owner emails.

\* Press "new private message" to send a new message.
